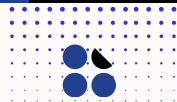


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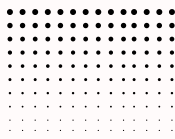
Introduction

We invite you to explore our 2026 offerings to support your role, develop confidence, and contribute to a culture of safe, exceptional care across our health system.





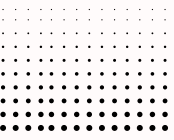
Vision & Mission
