They have many items available including wheelchairs, commodes, walkers, canes, shower chairs and many accessories. It works like a library. You check out the equipment needed for a duration of 1 day to 3 months and then return it when you are finished.

Clearview asks that the equipment is returned clean and in good condition with all accessories attached so it may be loaned out to others. Clearview requires the borrower to sign a contract stating what they are borrowing and when it will be returned. They must sign a waiver to release Clearview from all liabilities including injuries.
